

Kennel Club of Anne Arundel (KCAA) Breeder's Code of Ethics

Article A

1. As a breeder your primary goal for breeding should be to ensure the highest standard for your breed(s).
2. Breeders are encouraged to complete all relevant health testing of their breeding stock.
3. Breeders are encouraged to breed healthy, sound dogs with proper temperaments exhibiting appropriate type for their breed(s).
4. Breeders will keep accurate breeding records in accordance to AKC rules & regulations.

Article B

1. All sales of puppies and adults should include as a minimum the following:
 - AKC registration application or all information contained in AKC's application papers.
 - Signed Bill of Sale and/or Contract.
 - Health records.
 - Diet and breed appropriate information.
2. It is strongly recommended that puppies remain in their litter environment until they are at least 8 weeks of age.
3. Purchasers should be urged to spay or neuter all pets. Limited registrations should be made available to all companion pets. Full registrations should only be given to dogs that are free of disqualifying faults and are considered of breeding quality.

Article C

1. KCAA members will strive to be accurate, honest and forth right with all their breeding practices.
2. KCAA members will refuse to provide any animals to pet dealers, catalog houses, or any other commercial sources of distribution.
3. KCAA members will refuse to supply any animals for auctions, raffles, lotteries or other such activities.
